Job Description

As an intern, you will participate on a field crew to provide quality landscape services on a variety of commercial properties. This includes but is not limited to:

- Following the instruction and leadership of your assigned Account Manager
- Working alongside crew members to accomplish tasks
- Use and upkeep of maintenance equipment necessary for mowing, edging, blowing, and installing on properties
- Upholding all safety and performance standards of Landscape Workshop
- Communicating with several points of contact
- Participating in team meetings, trainings, and events as assigned
- Participating in monthly evaluations, written assignments, and final presentations to the Management Team

All positions are outdoors, very physical and fast paced. Weekly schedule may be four 10-hour days or five 8-hour days, depending on branch location. Estimated start time is 7:00am till 4:30pm. All schedules vary depending on branch location, traffic, weather and job tasks.
